The TRF show will be held on Saturday and Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. The shows will be held as they were before with the youth show on Saturday night and the Open Show on Sunday morning. Due to the release of the commercial cattle from the FFA youth show at the festival, longhorn cattle check-in will start at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Cattle not checked in prior to the show will not be allowed to enter the arena. This is a TLBAA qualifying show. The regulations in the TLBAA official handbook will be enforced.

Exhibitors 6 years and under are only eligible to show in the Pee Wee Exhibition Division and must be accompanied by an adult in the show arena.
