**INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL PARADE ENTRANTS (EXCEPT BANDS)**

Please be at parade registration tent at the parking lot of the Winnie Courthouse Annex (Broadway), no later than 10:00 a.m. for check in. You will receive your instructions at this time. The parade will begin promptly at 10:45 a.m. It is extremely important to be on time to allow sufficient time for proper line-up. **Any entrants later than 10:00 am will be placed at the end of the line-up.** A map of the parade route is enclosed. As shown on the map, the parade ends at the East Chambers School parking lot. It is very important for **ALL** entries to continue through the parade route without **stopping** in front of the main stage. This will avoid congestion and hesitations in the parade. Floats will unload in the East Chambers School parking lot, so everyone must ride their float and may be picked up at that location. **No one is to get off floats or out of line for any reason until you have reached the school.**

**\*THE TEXAS RICE FESTIVAL HAS THE AUTHORITY TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY THAT USES PROFANITY OR THAT WE FEEL IS INAPPROPRIATE FOR FAMILY VIEWING IN ANY WAY.**

All entrants will be assigned a line-up number for the parade. Numbers will be painted on the streets. Parade committee members will be available to assist you in locating your number. Committee members will be wearing identification badges. Cold water will be available at the corner of Broadway & 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets, as well as Chestnut Street, for everyone's convenience.

Once Highway 124 is blocked off, no traffic will be allowed down that street except for vehicles to be used in the parade.

Due to the physical exhaustion of young participants in the past, an age limit on marching participants has been set at 8 years. All participants under the age of 8 will be required to ride. Groups must provide their own vehicle.

**For safety reasons NO items of any kind may be thrown by parade participants.**

**BANDS**

Bands must be at parade line up no later than 9:45 a.m. The parade will start promptly at 10:45 a.m. For student drop off, band buses will turn from Hwy. 124 down Oak Street (next to Dannay's Donuts), continue to First Street (by M & J Fertilizer Co.), right onto Chestnut Street, where students will unload (see attached map). Buses may then go to the site of student pickup on St. Martin Street in the parking lot across from the Winnie-Stowell Park. Bands will line up on Chestnut Street according to the number given you and will enter the parade as their number comes up. Bands will not be stopping in front of the main stage. Bands will disperse in the parking lot at the bus site on St. Martin Street. **The Coca-Cola Bottling Company will serve complimentary Water or Powerade at the end of the parade route.**

## **ANTIQUÉ CARS**

Cars will be lined up on Broadway St. and fed into the parade at random. Antique cars will not be allowed to carry signs or in any way advertise for a business.

## **4-H AND HORSE CLUBS**

All entries will meet at 1<sup>st</sup> Street & Broadway Street. Before the parade begins, all horse trailers should be moved down Broadway St., right on Campbell Road, right on Buccaneer Dr. to the East Chambers School parking lot and park behind the football stadium. Riders will NOT be allowed to ride back through the parade route.

## **MOTORCYCLES**

Motorcycles will lead the parade. All bikes will meet at Pear Ave. & Hwy 124 in front of the First Baptist Church of Winnie. Line-up at 10:00 a.m.

## **ALL OTHERS**

All floats, vehicles, marching units, etc., will line up on Broadway St. You may enter from Hwy. 124 before 8:15 a.m. After 8:15 a.m., enter from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

**NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY OF THE LINE-UP STREETS IF NOT IN THE PARADE!**
